- ♦ Electronic filing is now mandatory. Please refer to the court's Notices to the Bar dated May 5, 2003 and June 16, 2003.
- ♦ CM/ECF Version 2.2 was loaded to the Live database on September 20, 2003. Participants should notice the following:
 - 1. When the court dockets an order, the docket text will now include the date the order was signed. This date will also appear on the *Notice of Electronic Filing*
 - 2. The linking process has been improved and will prevent the system from timing out in large cases. Use this <u>link</u> to view instructions.
 - 3. The U.S Trustee is now listed on the NEF under *Notice will be electronically mailed to*.

- ♦ When an attorney changes firms or the firm the attorney is currently associated with changes, a *Change of Law Firm* form must be submitted to the court via e:mail to: nancy sullivan@njb.uscourts.gov. The form is available on our web site under Forms/Our Court's Miscellaneous Forms.
- The mandatory use of the court's new Chapter 13 Plan and Motions form went into effect on April 1, 2003. Failure to submit the plan on the court's mandatory form will result in the matter being brought to the judge's attention. Please be advised that the standard language on the Chapter 13 Plan and Motions form, or other standard forms produced by the Court may not be altered.
- ♦ CM/ECF interprets some footnotes created in Microsoft Word documents as hyperlinks. Version 2.2 will not accept documents that include hyperlinks. Thus you will receive an error message and will be unable to proceed. Use this link to view **Footnote-Hyperlink Fix**.
