
**GENERAL ORDER IMPLEMENTING MANDATORY LOCAL FORM  
RELATING TO THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF,  
AND ECONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT**

**WHEREAS**, on March 27, 2020, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act was signed into law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Court having determined the need for a mandatory local form to address circumstances where a Chapter 13 debtor seeks plan modification due to a material financial hardship suffered during the COVID-19 pandemic;

**IT IS** hereby on this 9th day of December 2020 **ORDERED**:

1. Mandatory Local Form *Certification of Debtor(s) in Support of COVID-19 Chapter 13 Plan Modification* is implemented as of the date of this Order.
2. This Order shall remain in effect until further notice and is subject to interim revision as conditions may occur.
